1. Background of the Research

They may express A is B, differs from simile only in that comparison is implied rather than explicit. It means one subject compares with other subject and give significant different between the use of simile. Simply, metaphor is only defining two different things to give same comparison. For example: *her footstep was a light in the dance*. This theory helps the writer to analyze this study. Metaphor is an important element of figurative language, and the writer uses this element as the theory of this research.

According to Ullman (1962) there are many types of metaphor, they are consists of four types such as: anthropomorphic metaphor, animal metaphor, metaphor from concert to abstract, synesthetic metaphor. In this research the writer focuses on a part of figurative language of metaphor. A metaphor is a figure of speech that is used to make comparison between two things that are not alike but do have something in common. An example of metaphor is *I am the child of the court*, this example is just imagery words that described by the author. The sentence above

shows that 'I am' explained as the topic and 'court' as the image in this one. Furthermore, in this study analyzes types of metaphor as focus on this research and then collecting according to the expert's argument above as the additional reference completely. This is useful to the writer especially to find out the data comprehensively in this research. According to Newmark (1988:104) a metaphor is so significant that the purpose of metaphor is not merely referential but also pragmatic. The referential purpose is 'to describe a mental process or state, a concept, a person, an object, a quality or an action more comprehensively and concisely than is possible in literal or physical language. It means the metaphor is a process to make a comparison based on the topic and the image as tool or element from metaphor. In this case, the writer also concludes there are differences of argument from them but this study approaches to Ullman's theory it is because this one has the element and the character from the theory literally.

The writer chooses the metaphor as study because the writer wants to learn and share to the readers about this one formally. In this case, metaphor is a comprehension simply because many students still not understand related to the metaphor completely and the writer hopes with this thesis the readers can understand about comprehension as the concept of metaphor. The writer will analyze and observe the metaphor based on Ullman's theory (1962). However, the writer gives additional information to the readers about kind of metaphor in this study, they are: metaphor from concrete to abstract or abstract to concrete, anthropomorphic metaphor, synesthetic metaphor, and animal metaphor as the reference to the readers.
