CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Background of the Research

Swear words can be used to express our emotion or strong feeling. According to Jay and Janschewitz (2008) the main function of swearing is to express emotions, especially anger and frustration. For example, Andersson and Trudgill (in Lindahl, 2008) said that the word *fuck* can be used to express pain, pleasure, hate, and love depending on the context it appears.

We can find swear words in our society especially in the communication between people with same age. They can use swear words in order to show that they are best friends, for example the one the writer found in the source of data is "Slow-ass driver." The purpose of adding word ass here is just for joking because he just wants to tell that the driver to be slow and he add the word ass for humor.

When you are using swear words to a person you do not know it can be a problem because, generally swear words used to express anger or bad emotions. Kim (2020) states there are a number of English swear words used, such as *fuck*, *fuck you, shit, dick head, asshole, bitch, damn, bloody hell, choad, crikey, root, get stuffed, bugger me, fair suck of the sav, etc.* This inspires me to do the analysis about the swear words used in the movie entitled *Bad Boys* because in general swear words only used to express the users bad emotions or feelings and in this analysis
