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ABSTRACT

This is an analysis of the movie titled Only Mine. David Barragan is the main character who experiences psychological problems in his romantic relationship with his partner. David's psychological problem is obsessive love disorder. This analysis aims to describe the behaviors of obsessive love disorder and violent acts committed by David. The writer uses the psychological theory of Forward and Buck, namely obsessive love disorder. The data was analyzed using qualitative methods. From the fifteen obsessive love disorder behaviors, the writer only found eight types of behaviors of obsessive lover disorder. For these eight types of obsessive love disorder behaviors, there are 14 data found. For the thrill of new romance, the writer found 3 data, 1 data on rejection anxiety, 1 data on denying the undeniable, 1 data on acting through self-punishment, 1 data on telephone lifelines, 2 data on unannounced visits, 2 data on stalking, and finally there were 3 data on obsessive jealousy. Meanwhile, regarding the violent actions, the writer found 3 data about emotional violence, 2 data on against property, 1 data on physical violence, and finally 2 data on the obsession that leads to murder. David demonstrated gradual violence towards Julie, starting with emotional attacks, which made her afraid. He then attacked Julie's property, eventually resorting to physical violence, ultimately attempting to murder her. Proving that violence alone was insufficient for relationship maintenance. So it can be concluded that David, with an obsessive love disorder, aims to maintain his relationship with Julie, fearing his loss. Unconsciously, he resorts to violent actions, eventually killing Julie when she no longer wants to be with him.

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

Julie realized that her relationship with David already belonged to a toxic relationship. Julie also tried to stay away from David by asking her mother to call her acquaintance, Chief Dodd, to give a report and tell David to stay away from Julie. David's behavior increasingly made Julie frightened and paranoid.

Based on the explanation above, David's behavior manifested signs of obsessive love disorder. Obsessive love disorder is the desire to see your loved one thrive and become something else. Obsessive love disorder is a fixation on protecting or even controlling them. That feeling of love can turn into an obsession, and you may begin to see the person you love as more of a possession than an independent human being (Goldman).

People with obsessive love disorder, like those with other mental illnesses, have varying levels of intensity and desire to fulfill. As a result, the presence of this illness is not limited to obviously sick people because many behaviors of mental illnesses go unnoticed by the untrained eye. Some people may be open about their behavior, while others may be more subtle. The behavior is usually an overwhelming attraction to one person, obsessive thoughts about the person, a need to protect the person in love, possessive thoughts and actions, and extreme jealousy over other interpersonal interactions. Obsessive love Disorder (OLD) is a relatively uncommon illness that few people are aware of because it affects less than 0.1 percent of the population (Cherney).

As mentioned above by Cherney, only a few people know about obsessive love disorder. This shows that many people who are in a relationship do not realize that their behavior could be categorized into Obsessive Love Disorder. Therefore, as a writer, I would like to raise this topic in my research which will explain how people with obsessive love disorder behave and the impact of obsessive love disorder, so that this research can at least help readers to understand about obsessive love disorder.

The urgency of this research raises an issue that is so close to our lives which is love. Love is one of the most relevant aspects of human life because it has a significant impact on relationships, emotions, and social interactions. Love is a universal substance that is an essential component of human life. Ahmadi et al affirm love is often represented as an all-consuming emotion, people who are in love do everything in their power to gain the kinds of love they want or believe they deserve. If exaggerated, this can lead to actions that encourage people to reach out for love and do everything in their power to get it. This behavior can also be triggered by mental illness, as well as social learning processes and cultural influences. Childhood developmental experiences, such as the formation of social attachments, can also result in obsessive love (697).

The reason the writer chose *Only Mine* is that the movie is based on a true story. *Only Mine* can be proven as the fact that obsessive love disorder happens in the real world. Movies based on their true stories can take the audience deeper into the real human experience. They remind us that the challenges of obsessive love disorder are all around us.
