CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter is devided into two sections; they are the conclusion and the suggestions.

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the results of data analysis that have been discussed in the previous chapter, the researcher makes some conclusion about the factors causing the eleventh grade students difficulties in speaking English of SMAN 1 Mukomuko as follows:

- 1. There are two main factors causing the students' difficulties in speaking English. They are internal factor (59%) and external factor (66%).
- 2. The internal factors causing the students difficulties are anxiety (64%), shyness (63%), motivation (68%), students knowledge (50,36%).
- 3. The external factors causing the students difficulties are teacher teaching materials (83%), management in teaching English (68%), school environment (65%).

5.2 Suggestion

Teachers should pay attention to both internal and external factors when teaching English speaking, particularly motivation (internal factor) and teachers' teaching materials (external factor).

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
