Moreover, the utilization of qualitative methodology enables the researcher to delve deeply into the nuances of language usage, facilitating a nuanced understanding of the underlying dynamics at play.

Set in California, the show revolves around Devi Vishwakumar, an Indian-American teenager navigating the complexities of high school, friendships, and family life. The series premiered in April 2020 and has garnered widespread acclaim for its witty writing, authentic portrayal of teenage experiences, and diverse representation. By analyzing slang words in the context of Never Have I Ever Season 1, researchers can gain valuable insights into the dynamic nature of language, the role of slang in shaping cultural identity, and the ways in which language reflects and influences social interactions within contemporary society.

# 3.3 Technique of Collecting and Coding the Data

An analytical framework is then developed, often involving thematic, narrative, or discourse analysis. A coding scheme is created to categorize the data, identifying recurring themes and patterns. A detailed analysis follows, applying and refining the coding scheme. The coded data is synthesized to identify

overarching themes, ensuring rigor through strategies like triangulation, peer review, and maintaining an audit trail. Saldaña emphasizes the iterative nature of coding and the importance of researcher reflexivity to minimize biases (Saldaña, 2016).

To analyze slang usage in *Never Have I Ever* Season 1, the writer follows Johnny Saldaña's techniques. Firstly, the writer engages in multiple viewings to immerse in the dialogue and interactions, focusing on slang terms, colloquialisms, and other linguistic features, noting their frequency, context, and connotations. Systematic note-taking is crucial, documenting specific examples of slang words and phrases along with their contexts and interpretations.

Utilizing data coding techniques, the writer categorizes observations, assigning codes to identify slang terms, character interactions, or thematic elements, which helps streamline the analysis process and identify patterns. Consultation with experts in linguistics or cultural studies enriches the data collection, providing additional perspectives on the linguistic phenomena portrayed.

To ensure accuracy and reliability, the writer cross-references observations with the series' script, validating findings through comprehensive scrutiny. This rigorous, methodical approach, combining careful observation, note-taking, data coding, and consultation, aims to uncover the socio-linguistic dynamics and cultural significance within the series' dialogue and interactions, following Saldaña's systematic techniques (Saldaña, 2016).

## 3.4 Technique of Analyzing The Data

Following the meticulous collection of data, the next stage of the research process covers a detailed examination of the gathered material. This analytical attempt is carried out methodically, to create a full description and establish the complex connections that exist within the issue under consideration. Using the descriptive qualitative approach, this study delves into an extensive range of data collected from the Netflix series *Never Have I Ever* Season 1, aiming to uncover the subtle nuances within the dialogue and relationships depicted.

Guided by Mattiello's (2008) classification system for slang word formation processes, the analysis discerns and categorizes various slang terms utilized throughout the series. These slangs are meticulously classified into distinct categories such as Acronym, Blending, Clipping, Compounding, Prefixation, Suffixation, Infixation, Final Combining Forms, Conversion, Back-formation, Reduplicative, Semantic Shift, Reversed Forms, Variation, Word Manufacture, and Fanciful Formation. This structured framework provides a comprehensive understanding of the diverse linguistic expressions employed within the narrative. Furthermore, aligned with the research topic and objectives, this study not only examines the slang word development processes in *Never Have I Ever* but also explores and explicates the meanings of these slang words.

Drawing upon the insights of Morse (1996), advocates for a structured approach to thematic analysis in qualitative research, aiming to uncover clear themes and patterns from data to derive meaningful interpretations. Her method begins with data familiarization, involving repeated readings and viewing to grasp the data's content, nuances, and contextual intricacies. Morse recommends starting coding with open coding, where meaningful segments of data are identified and labeled as codes to represent key concepts or themes. Subsequently, these codes are organized into broader themes and patterns that capture the essence of the data and reflect emerging central ideas. Thematic mapping is then employed to visualize relationships between themes and sub-themes, creating a coherent narrative or conceptual framework. Throughout this process, Morse emphasizes verification and interpretation to ensure the coherence and consistency of themes across the dataset and their relevance to the research questions. This systematic approach enables researchers to uncover, organize, and interpret underlying meanings and patterns within qualitative data systematically, facilitating insightful conclusions.

In essence, the analysis process unfolds as a rigorous and systematic exploration of the collected data, guided by the principles of descriptive qualitative research. Through meticulous classification, interpretation, and validation, the analysis aims to unravel the complexities of slang usage within the series, shedding light on its structural properties, semantic nuances, and socio-cultural implications.

Additionally, Tracy emphasizes narrative analysis, which centers on understanding the structural elements and storytelling techniques used by authors and filmmakers to convey meaning and evoke emotions. Her approach also includes frame analysis, particularly valuable for analyzing visual media like movies, where researchers examine specific scenes or shots to interpret visual compositions and symbolic representations. Tracy integrates visual coding techniques as well, allowing researchers to categorize and interpret visual data based on thematic and narrative criteria. Throughout these methods, Tracy emphasizes the significance of interpretation and synthesis, urging researchers to contextualize coded themes and visual elements within the broader narrative context.

One aspect of representing data involves organizing and categorizing slang word formation process terms identified within the series according to predefined criteria, aligning with qualitative methodologies proposed by Tracy (2013). This includes grouping terms based on their linguistic characteristics, contextual usage, or thematic relevance into categories such as Acronym, Blending, Clipping, Compounding, and others as outlined by Mattiello (2008).
