CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the finding and discussion, it can be concluded that the third year students' ability to mastering adjective complement by using noun clause and phrase at English Department of Bung Hatta University was low. The conclusion was indicated by the fact that there were 1 student (4,17%) had very good ability, 4 students (16,67%) had good ability, 3 students (12,5%) had moderate ability, 16 students (66,66%) had low ability. The detailed ability is as follows:

1. The third year students' ability to mastering adjective complement by using noun clause at English Department of Bung Hatta University was low. It was supported by the fact there were 0 student (0%) who had very good ability, 4 students (16,67%) who had good ability, 1 students (4,17%) who had moderate ability, and 19 students (79,16%) who had low ability.

2. The third year students' ability to mastering adjective complement by using noun phrase at English Department of Bung Hatta University was low. It was supported by the fact there were 3 students (12,5%) who had very good ability, 4 students (16,67%) who had good ability, 2 students (8,33%) who had moderate ability, and 15 students (62,5%) who had low ability.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the conclusion above, the researcher gives suggestions to the students and lecturers.

- 1. To the students
 - a. The third year students who have very good ability and good ability in mastering adjective complement by using noun clause and phrase are suggested to maintain their ability.
 - b. The third year students who have moderate ability and low ability in mastering adjective complement by using noun clause and phrase are suggested to do more exercises.
- 2. To lecturers

The researcher suggests lecturers to increase the students ability in mastering adjective complement by using noun clause and phrase and more explanation about adjevtive complement by using noun clause and phrase.

3. Further Reseracher

The researcher suggests the next researcher to do related research, like to find out the factors that caused the students have problems in mastering adjective complement by using noun clause and phrase.

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
