CONCLUSION

This research focuses on the women oppression and women resistance towards the women oppression. The oppression of women occurs because men want women according to their desire, even though it is an injustice for women. This injustice occurs after a government decision. The data of the women oppression is found in *Vox* written by Christina Dalcher. Three types of women oppression found in the novel are lack of freedom for women and injustice in job for women.

The women oppression is experienced by the characters in this novel. The women oppression happens because there is a government regulation that women are only allowed to speak 100 words a day and are not allowed to work outside the home, and women are only allowed to do household chores. This oppression also applies to girls who are still young and attending school. It happens because characters often experience women oppression. The dominant data of women oppression is lack of freedom for women.

In this study, women resistance toward the women oppression can be categorized into three, namely the underground resistance group, accepting job offer and demonstration against the rules of the government. The resistance happens because of disagreement with decisions and the desire to fight against the injustices that occur. However, some of the resistance was unsuccessful. It can conclude that women oppression experienced by characters is lack of freedom for women and injustice in job for women. Injustice is formed from the male perspective towards women which causes women to experience difficulties carrying out their daily lives. The resistance that is carried out is useful for returning a women life to normal. This research is proven by the existence of quotations from the novel as data and evidence from the women oppression and the women resistance toward the women oppression.
