

CHAPTER V CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter, the researcher discusses conclusions and suggestions. Those are made by the results of this research.

5.1 Conclusions

Based on the findings, in general, it can be concluded that the second year students' listening ability to comprehend short dialogue was low (37.84%). Specifically, the conclusion of the study are as the followings :

1. The listening ability of the second year students' of Bung Hatta University in identifying topic was very high. It was provided by the fact that 15 students (40.54%) had very high ability.
2. The listening ability of the second year students' of Bung Hatta university in recognizing suggestion was low. It was provided by the fact that 23 students (62.16%) had low ability.

1.2 Suggestions

Reffering to the conclusion, the researcher would like to propose several suggestion for the lecturer, students and the next researchers.

1. For the lecturers, they are suggested to give more exercise to students on recognizing suggestion by using audio to improve their students' listening ability.
2. For students, they are suggested to improve their ability in listening to comprehending short dialogue especially in recognizing suggestion , since the

findings showed that the students ability was low. It can be done by doing more practice to listening to short dialogue.

3. For the further researchers, the researcher hopes that they can conduct a study to investigate how students can have low ability in recognizing suggestion of short dialogue.
