

## V. CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

The result of the analysis of *Anne with an e* movie has helped me to come to the following conclusions and suggestion.

### 5.1 Conclusions

In this research, the writer research semantic. In semantics, there are elements of that means, specifically literal meaning and non-literal meaning. in non-literal meaning, there's this kind of element as figurative language. According to Kennedy Figurative language is divided into seven types, they are Metaphore, Simile, Personification, Hyperbole, Allusion, Metonymy, and Symbol. The researcher focuses on finding hyperbole, According to Claridge (2011:5), hyperbole is a phrase that goes beyond the literal expression and includes extra semantic characteristics. We may deduce from these definitions that hyperbole is a figure of speech that emphasizes a meaning by exaggerating a statement. Hyperbole is a common occurrence in everyday discourse. Its purpose is to emphasize a funny impact in everyday discourse.

Based on the research findings, there is some point that answers the research questions. There are seven forms of hyperbole found in *Anne with an e* movie which are Single-word, Phrasal, Clausal, Numerical, The role of the superlative, Comparison, and Repetition. In this research, the writer found 50 data. Single-word 7 data, Phrasal 7 data, Clausal 5 data, Numerical 10 data, The role of the superlative 2 data, Comparison 16 data, and Repetition 3 data found.

This research analyzes the forms of hyperbole used based on the theory of Claridge (2011) which categorized hyperbole into seven different forms: (1)

Single-word, (2) Phrasal, (3) Clausal, (4) Numerical, (5)The role of the superlative, (6) Comparison, and (7) Repetition.

## **5.2 Suggestions**

The researcher proposes some suggestions according to the result of the findings. The researcher suggests understanding the figurative language, especially for the readers and other students who interest in analyzing the literary work in short about the movie.
