CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter, the researcher draws some conclusions and suggestions about this research baed on the findings that has been discissed previously.

5.1 Conclusions

Based on the result of data analysis that have been discussed in the previous chapter, the researcher made some conclusions of the third year students' ability to write simple sentence by using verb collocation at English Department of Bung Hatta University. The researcher made three conclusions of this study as follows:

- 1. In general, the ability of the third year students' at English Department of Bung Hatta University to write simple sentence by using verb collocation "do", was indicated had 3 (9,67%) very good ability, 0 good ability, 0 moderate ability, and 28 (90%) had low ability, it was proved by the data.
- 2. The students' ability to writing simple sentence by using verb collocation "make" was 3 (9,67%) very good ability, 0 good ability, 0 moderate ability, and 28 (90%) had low ability. It was proved by the data.
- 3. The students' ability to writing simple sentence by using verb collocation "have" was 3 (9,67%) very good ability, 0 good ability, 0 moderate ability, and 28 (90%) had low ability. It was proved by the data.

5.2 Suggestions

Based on the conclusions above the researcher would like to give some suggestions, that can be proposed to students and the other researcher:

- 1. For students, they still need to be aware of using collocations because they just cannot combine word freely for words have their own natural combination.
- 2. For the other researcher, this study only looked for the use lexical collocation, verb+noun and adjective+noun collocations. Type beyond these two kinds of collocation and grammatical collocation need to be identified, we can have a clearer and complete picture of the use of collocation.

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
