

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on the results of data analysis, it is confirmed that expressive speech acts are found after observing and analyzing the data. To be more specific, the expressive speech act includes 168 utterances based on three posts with the caption “*what do you mean*” “*yummy*” and “*hold tight.*” Each of them belongs to the expressive speech acts of 29 thanking, 3 apologizing, 25 greeting, 23 wishing, and also expressive speech act of 88 praising. Each of these types has been analyzed to find its strategies and function based on its context. The strategies found are direct and indirect. Meanwhile, the functions found are to express gratitude, regret, interrupt, address, asking someone’s condition, welcome, desire, wish, admire and praise.

According to the findings of the preceding research, the most common type is the expressive speech act of praising because it can be seen in the number of how many comments found, while the strategy that is frequently used is direct, it because directly uses the word as the types of expressive speech act, and the function is to express praise. In this case, it is a sense of praise or admiration given by Justin Bieber's Instagram followers to Justin Bieber who held his concert tour called Justice World Tour which was uploaded on his Instagram account. in several video posts of this concert tour, Justin Bieber got very good feedback and response from his followers, especially from his fans on his Instagram account.

So, it can be concluded that some of the video posts during the Justice World Tour were enjoyed, looked forward and enthusiastic by Justin Bieber's followers in case this concert tour will be the last world tour of Justin Bieber before he hiatus from the entertainment world and focus on his personal life. Lastly, the video posts have reached

the right targets because Justin Bieber got a lot of positive responses in the comments column on his Instagram account during the Justice World Tour.

5.2 Suggestion

This research is complemented by several suggestions to other researchers who want to analyze expressive speech acts on Justin Bieber's Instagram comments during the *Justice World Tour* as follows.

1. The existence of multifunctional findings on expressive speech act type functions can be developed by future researchers for comparison with other linguistic fields such as sociolinguistics.
2. The researcher can find mixed expressive speech acts in comments by a follower on Justin Bieber's Instagram account.
3. The researcher can also find slang words used by Justin Bieber's Instagram followers, as well as the use of emoticons, which are classified as semiotic.
4. This research can undoubtedly be used to increase knowledge and learn about expressive speech acts that are commonly used in social media.
